history

- Triathlon is a three-part sports discipline comprised of swimming, cycling and running. The three sports are contested as a continuous event without a rest.
- The first triathlon event was held on Sept. 25, 1974.
- In 1994, the sport was awarded Olympic status and was featured for the first time at the 2000 Summer Olympic Games in Sydney, Australia. Since then, the sport has grown dramatically.
- In 1989, the International Triathlon Union (ITU) was founded in Avignon, France and the first official world championships were held.

USA Triathlon

- USA Triathlon (USAT) is the National Governing Body for the sports of triathlon, duathlon, aquathlon, aquabike, winter triathlon, and paratriathlon in the United States and operates under the umbrellas of the International Triathlon Union and the U.S. Olympic Committee.
- We provide regulation, encouragement and support for race directors, coaches, officials and athletes.
- USA Triathlon owns and produces the Collegiate National Championship, Duathlon National Championship, Junior National Championship, and the Age Group & Sprint National Championships.
